Grading: Rustic

A104 is a rustic grade floor, meaning it will contain varying amounts of live and dead filled knots. In addition, the floor will contain Heartwood and Sapwood, offering a wider range of colour variation, and Expert Checks can be expected (cracks along the growth ring). The colour of the filler used on this floor is intended to complement the natural structure of the wood, and such may contrast the surrounding timber, as can be seen in knots. This may vary from batch to batch.

Maintenance: Oiled Floor Care



Sweep with a soft bristle brush, or the parquet attachment on your vacuum cleaner. Always ensure you are using PH Neutral cleaners and avoid soaking the floor with water. Avoid scratches by minimising grit and dust, install doorway entrance mats and felt pads to protect furniture. Periodic re-oiling may be required through the floor lifetime.
