PREPARATION

First remove loose dirt and grit from your floor using a Bona Microfiber Dusting Pad or Vacuum cleaner.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Mist cleaner onto a section of the floor and then wipe clean. Continue to clean the floor section by section. Rinse and wring out cleaning pad as it becomes soiled.

On stubborn spots, spray some cleaner directly onto the spot and let it work a few minutes before scrubbing and wiping off.

Avoid leaving your mop standing with a wet cleaning pad face-down on the floor surface when done cleaning – this may cause permanent damage to your surface.

REFILLING

Bona Oiled Wood Floor Cleaner is available in a 2.5 litre economy sized refill so you don't have to buy a new spray mop bottle every time you run out of cleaner.
